





History

- History dates back to 1950 when Mrs Roosevelt (Unicef) visited Rovaniemi and Arctic Circle
 - First building Roosevelt cottage was built
 - First Arctic Circle postal stamp was launched
- 1984 first concorde (British airways) landed to
 Rovaniemi => Beginning of the Christmas tourism
- 1985 Santa Claus stated to have an office in Arctic Circle
- Santa Claus has been there daily basis since 1992
- Rovaniemi received the status of the Official Hometown of Santa Claus[®] in 2010
- 2016 Visit Rovaniemi and the City of Rovaniemi were granted the President's Internationalisation Award by President of Finland Sauli Niinistö



General Information

- Open every single day of the year 365
- No entrance fee, pay only "what you experience"
- Santa Claus can be met free of charge every day of the year
- App. 50 private companies in the attraction
 - Santa Claus, Santa Claus' Main Post Office, Santa Claus Reindeer, Mrs Santa Claus, huskies, snowmobiling, petting zoo, Elf School etc
 - Hotels, restaurants, cafes, shopping, activity companies...
- The Arctic Circle is a circle of latitude that runs 66°33′45.9″ north of the Equator. It marks the southernmost latitude where the sun can stay continuously below or above the horizon for 24 hours these phenomena are known as the Midnight Sun in the summer and the Polar Night ("Kaamos") in the winter.

- 6. Shopping & coffee break




Tips for organizing guided tour (experiences to pay)

- 12. Join an outdoor activity of Wild Nordic




Practical tips
